



Rules and Regulations

These are in addition to those contained on the back of your contract and any rules, regulations or laws set forth by the Orange County Convention Center and local law enforcement agencies.

- 1) Main aisle ways as set forth on the floorplan and approved by the Fire Department may not be obstructed or altered in any way. Bow pulpits may not extend into the main aisles ways. We will have many fire inspections prior to the show opening. Displays must not interfere with access to the exits, visibility of exits or exit signs.
- 2) No sound equipment or sound making devices which can be heard outside exhibit areas will be permitted.
- 3) Exhibitors must use only professional looking signs. Signs must be confined to exhibit area and not extend across main aisles.
- 4) Persons working your display will be confined to working directly in your exhibit area. Aisles are considered common ground.
- 5) Exhibitors that carpet their area must have it meet the aisle carpet and be secured to the floor with tape approved by the OCCC. No display may use the same color carpeting as the main aisles-Red. No carpet for the hot summer boat show.
- 6) Everyone working your display must have an exhibitor badge to obtain free admission. Badges will not be issued once the show opens.
- 7) Booth and display areas must be kept clean and free of litter. Our display decorator, FM convention Contractors, can provide overnight cleaning if needed.
- 8) Show management reserves the right to restrict exhibits which are or may become objectionable and to prohibit any exhibit which may detract from the general character of the show. This restriction and prohibition extends to persons and their conduct, printed materials, or any thing of a character which may detract from the general character of the show. This restriction and prohibition extends to persons and their conduct, printed materials, or any thing of a character which may not being keeping with the character of the show.
- 9) No booth may exceed the 8' backdrop or the 3' side divider height. Specific approval for any exception must come from show management. Booths are defined as 10' x 10' exhibits within the main hall(s) and lobby areas.
- 10) Vehicles are prohibited from entering the building at anytime during set-up, show hours, and tear down unless they are towing a boat or boat trailer. Hand carts and dollies may be used to move exhibitor items. Please contact show management for special consideration.
- 11) We maintain 24 hour security beginning when the staging lot opens at 6:00am through Monday at 4:00pm when the staging lot closes. However, CFMTA or the OCCC will not be held responsible for any losses incurred.
- 12) Exhibitors shall cooperate with other exhibitors and provide adequate staff to be able to adhere to set-up and tear-down schedules.
